Amuseument part bumper car (a) with metal pole (b). (a) Amusement park bumper car. Car with elongated oval shape, one-piece molded fiberglass body, with styling reminiscent of a an automobile. Decorated with a two-tone paint scheme, blue-green and cream white. Chrome-plated accent trim, including front grille with operable headlamps. Hood ornament featuring crossed racing flags, and side moldings with insignia. Cockpit features upholstered bench-style seat, steering wheel with heavily padded hub, and round foot pedal switch on floorboard. Electrical pickup mast. (b) Metal pole, fits into socket located behind the driver. Top of post has a spring-steel shoe which would have conducted electricity from an energized metal ceiling in the ride pavilion, to power the vehicle.
