Description

Miner's kerosene lamp. Conical-shaped brass body with soldered seams. Round hinged cap with vent hole. Tapered spout soldered to body with round guard around mouth. Bent wire hanging hook with a pointed tip is soldered in a socket opposite the spout. All other components are a different silver metal than the body, possibly tin. Stamped maker's mark on the front of the spout showing an eagle with banner above and below with text.
