hinged lid; (b) Oval-shape dish with ornate cast legs having hoof-shaped feet; divided inside into two separate halves, each having a hinged lid with engraved decoration; wooden knobs and lifting handle; (c) Alcohol burner with snap-on cap; (d) Deep tray with ring-end lifting handles; (e) Lid for tray above with folding loop handle; (f) Fuel reservoir with knurled filler cap and dispensing tube.
