Description

Sheraton-style cherry stand with one drawer. (a) Square cherry wood stand. Four legs with apron. Top is made of two pieces of wood. Each leg has turned decoration at top and bottom. Round feet. Exterior of table is stained. Handwritten numerals/text in graphite on the interior of the left apron. (b) Pull-out drawer with original Bakewell colorless pressed glass knob at front center. Knob has two seams. Knob's round face has rope-edge design around the perimeter and eight raised dots (bull's eyes) over a diamond-point ground; direct center of face has rounded

metal screwhead. The screw runs through knob neck and through the front of the drawer to the drawer interior where it is secured with a square nut. Knob neck has horizontal ridge design consisting of eleven rings. Round base that is inset into the wood. The Bakewell mark is likely on the end of the knob that is inset into the wood. Drawer has dovetail joints at each corner fastened with metal nails.
