Salt-glazed stoneware sorage jar, four-gallon capacity; light-gray body, with bold deep cobalt-blue decoration; interior does not have albany-slip lining; tall, cylinder shape, bulges slightly at shoulder, with two molded(?) attached handles; pronounced lip at top, with wide, flat, rim; brush-decorated on two sides: vine and four-petalled trumpet flower over numeral on one side, opposite side has vine/flower only; brushed lines at neck and attachment points of handles.
