Description

Salt-glazed stoneware storage jar, probably used to hold tobacco or snuff; light gray color, smooth-sided cylindrical form, tapering inward slightly at the neck; inside of rim has a concave flared shelf, apparently to fit a tapered sealing lid; interior of vessel has a dark-brown Albany-slip glaze; face of jar is stencilled with maker information; most of the jar's base is unglazed.
