Round-shape snap-on filler cap with vent hole and wire-ring hinge. Long tapered spout soldered to body, with a round dish-like wick guard near the tip. A bent-wire hanging hook w/ pointed tip is soldered in a socket opposite the spout. Fiber wicking material inserted in spout.
