## Jar, Snuff

### Date

1890-1910

### Medium

earthenware with ceramic overglaze

### Description

Stoneware snuff jar (a) with lid (b). (a) Small stoneware snuff jar: ovoid shape, with very tall, slightly flared neck; light cream-color clay body, very smooth off-white Bristol slip glazing; vessel appears to have been press-moulded in two sections, and then wedged together at a point just below the shoulder; wide mouth has a deeply-recessed internal shelf, into which fits lid. (b) Lid for snuff jar. Press-moulded round, flat lid, glazed to match the jar, with recessed button-style lift handle at center
