Description

Prototype stained glass window for East Liberty Presbyterian Church. Window consists of a depiction of the Adoration of the Magi. In the center of the glass, Baby Jesus is sitting on Mary's lap. There are three men showing in robes and wearing crowns in the scene; one of the men is kneeling in front of Mary and Jesus, presenting them with a gift, while the other two men stand in the background, also holding gifts. There are three angels depicted above this scene. In the lower section, there is a depiction of an angel speaking to three shepherds, who are kneeling with their staffs in front of the angel.
