Description

Oil painting on Baltic birch panel. Rectangular. Depiction of houses and the view of ridgelines in the Ridgemont neighborhood of Pittsburgh. The foreground of the painting depicts a yellow house in the center with a reddish brown roof and white trim. Green shrubbery along the lower right edge of the house, in the right foreground. To the left is a light blue house with a gray roof and white trim. Right mid-ground of the painting depicts other houses in the distance, as well as a tall green pine tree behind the yellow house. Beyond these houses are more green pine trees. Background, on the left, features green ridgelines, and in the distance across the top-center section are blue ridgelines. Top section shows clear blue sky. Artist's signature in the lower right corner painted in black. Front of painting covered in transparent varnish. Sides are painted gray. Unpainted back. Text on back in black ink: in the top left corner is the series number, across the top-center is the title, in the top right corner is the date, and across the lower center section is the artist name. Wood cleat glued to center on back.
