Description

Oil painting on Baltic birch panel. Rectangular. Depicts scene of four houses in the Central Lawrenceville neighborhood of Pittsburgh. In the center foreground is a red brick structure with two red chimneys, probably a duplex from the two-toned roof (left side is brown, right side is green). In the center foreground the house on the left side has a triangular-shaped attachment with a white chimney. The sunlight has created shade on the lower half of the house on the left, and almost completely over the house on the right. Also in the foreground is a gray wooden-panel fence that extends from left to center right, and a silver (metal) fence that extends from center right to the right edge. There is a yellow house on the left side of the scene in midground, and a light blue-gray house on the right side of the scene in the background. Blue-gray sky across top section of scene. Artist's signature in the lower left corner painted in red. Front of painting covered in transparent varnish. Sides are painted gray. Unpainted back. Text on back in black ink: in top left corner is the series number, across the top center is the title, and in the lower center section is the artist name. Wood cleat glued to center on back.
