White, oval, bowled ceramic serving dish with blue and yellow floral and bird imagery. This dish features an alternating pattern of a blue and yellow bird surrounded by yellow flowers and blue leaves, and a floral motif of yellow flowers and blue leaves. There are two handles with two holes and decorative gold dots and lines on opposite side of the dish. The rim of the dish has a gold line that breaks and swirls at the handles. The name of this pattern in unknown. There are three stilt marks on the underside of the dish. There is a stamped green Maker's Mark in the center of the underside of the dish. The glaze has crazing and the gold lines are faded at the handles.
