Description

Hat-maker's form or mold. A tall, dome-topped bowler style shape, with wide perpendicular brim, with an upright band encircling the rim. The form appears to be made from an adhesive-impregnated woven gauze material, which has been completely covered by strips of brown paper-mache. A long hat-pin with a black-glass head has been inserted into the crown.
