Description

Brass trumpet said to have been used in conjunction with the Vigilante pumper, used by Vigilante, Pittsburgh's first volunteer fire company. Ridge below flared bell, round tapered shaft, oblong flared mouthpiece. Brass is discolored with black spots on bell-shaped section. Circular hook under bell section to hang trumpet.
