Description

Short, wide storage jar, possibly a small butter churn, stoneware with a very heavy salt glaze, firing to a dark gray-green color; brushed cobalt decoration of lines and sweeping shapes; Albany-slip interior; two very robust arch-shaped pulled handles at top of vessel; tall, straight rim flange with interior shelf to fit a recessed lid or churn top; stamped at shoulder with number and maker's mark.
