Description

White ceramic pitcher (b) with lid (a) in pattern #2467. (a) White pitcher lid with four floral images. The images are equally spaced along the rim and consist of red and orange flowers with green and purple leaves. There is a handle in the center of the lid with a green line running down the middle. There is a thick lip on the base meant to fit inside the pitcher. There is a chip on the spout portion of the rim. In ink on the underside of the lid is the pattern information. The glaze has crazing. (b) White pitcher with floral motifs. There are two identical motifs on the sides of the pitcher featuring red and orange flowers with green, blue, and purple leaves. There is a green line down the center of the handle. On the underside of the base stamped in green is maker information. The glaze has crazing. There is discoloration on the inside and outside of the pitcher. There is a chip on the rim of the base.
