Description

Stoneware wax-sealer or canning jar; tall cylindrical shape, tapered inward at neck, delineated with incised bands; flaring upper rim, interior of which is formed into a recessed flange, to accept a sealing lid or cap (not intact); pale orange-red body clay has fired to a dark grey/tan, with a heavily pebbled or textured glossy salt glaze; bold cobalt stencilling has maker information; dark-brown albanyslip coating inside; large kiln furniture scars on
