Description

Handmade female doll representing regional Italian dress (a) with detached earring (b). Painted ceramic head, shoulders, forearms, and lower legs with remaining body made of cloth. Brown painted hair and blue eyes. Offwhite woven/lace headdress. Off-white woven fabric long-sleeve shirt with lace collar and cuffs and red fabric forearms. Vest made of woven multi-colored fabric with white trim along front opening and criss-cross brown cord down front. Two earrings that are gold chain with one faux-pearl on each end; proper right earring is in place

and proper left earring is detached (b). Four strings of green-brown beaded necklaces. Black floor-length skirt with gold brocade fabric around the bottom. Brown apron. White fabric underskirt (petticoat) and pantalets. Painted brown heeled boots. Paper label pinned with metal straight pin on the interior side of the apron; the label has printed black text on one side and handwritten text on the other; label was removed to object file. [Part b, detached earring, is not directly marked with the catalog number.]
