



## Recorder, Audio Wire

### Primary Maker

Webster-Chicago

### Medium

Wood; Fabric; Metal; Rubber; Celluloid; Glass; Paper; Ink; Leather

### Description

Webster-Chicago wire recorder (a) with detachable lid (b).

Rectangular wood case covered in dark red fabric surface covering. Case's proper left long side has red celluloid(?) handle; front short side has two metal latches; proper right long side has four rubber bumpers; back short side has rectangular fabric vent, two metal hinges, metal plug, and metal maker's plate; underside has rectangular metal grate with four vacuum tubes inside. Inside case is recording equipment. Bottom of inside is silver metal with recording wheels at back and speaker lines at front; numerous knobs for adjusting the machine settings; maker's marks in red text. Top of inside is covered in brown fabric and from top to bottom there is a compartment that hinges open, three knobs, a paper instruction sheet, and two round rubber cups.
