Description

Colorless glass covered butter dish. Bryce Brothers' pattern #125, also known as Rose in Snow pattern.

Originally colorless, though both pieces of this item have solarized and have a slight purple cast. (a) Base. Flared, open, round bowl. The side/brim has a stippled background and 3 roses, each with leaves, 2 stems and 1 blossom and 1 bud. On one of the roses there is a large bubble in the small set of 6 leaves. The rim is clear and flares out, and finishes on the interior with a ledge for the lid to sit on. Footring is clear and encircles an 18-panel, stippled starburst with raised edges on the panels. Straw mark on the center. (b) Lid. Rounded with the same rose and stippling pattern as on the base. The rim is clear and is slightly flared, with a barely articulated step on the interior. The finial sits on a stippled, rounded "foot", and has a faceted (6-sided) baluster shape, which finishes in a 6-sided point.
