# Description

Colorless glass champagne goblet. McKee Brothers' Bellflower pattern, also known as Ribbed Leaf pattern or

Ribbed Bellflower pattern. Rounded bowl, which is slightly concave at the rim. Design on the bowl consists of a single vine undulating horizontally through the middle of the body with 1 bellflower, 1 leaf, and 1 shamrock-shaped leaf above the vine, and one of each below the vine. The background is ribbed and extends almost all the way to the rim on the exterior; the inside of the bowl is smooth. 6-paneled stem and collar with angular knop; looking into the interior of the bowl, the panels at the collar form a circle with a hexagonal center. On the foot, the panels of the stem finish in a rounded step. The foot is slightly concave with a ribbed starburst on the underside. 1/2 inch band between the starburst and the foot rim. Very few bubbles throughout. Glass has solarized and has distinctive purple cast.
