Description

Gold-tone, boat-shaped souvenir comprise of a boat (a), a sail (b), and a paddle (c). (a) Model of the bottom section of a boat, compromise of narrow strips of metal that appear to resemble bamboo or reeds. Two bars of metal lay perpendicular on front and back of boat, and are nailed into other strips. Metal bar across center has a small hole in center, which part b fits into. Two narrow strips of metal lay on top of center and back section of boat. Circular cup nailed to front of boat. Four metal feet on bottom with four black rubber tips. (b) Gold-tone metal sail. Sail is attached to straight metal pole. Sail is slightly shaped like a "c", with the right side shorter and the left side longer and stretched out. Red text in English and Chinese on front. (c) Gold-tone metal paddle. Paddle has handle on one end, with wide, curved edge on the other.
