Description

Colorless glass spooner. McKee Brothers' Bellflower pattern, also known as Ribbed Leaf pattern or Ribbed

Bellflower pattern. Colorless, footed spooner (probably--could not confirm) with a rounded body that flares slightly. Design consists of a single vine undulating horizontally through the middle of the body with 1 bellflower, 1 leaf, and 1 shamrock-shaped leaf above the vine, and one of each below the vine. The background is ribbed and extends to 1/8" clear band at the rim; the inside is smooth. 6-paneled neck that becomes a stepped collar. 1/2" clear band between collar and ribbing. Looking into the bowl, the collar forms hexagon encircled by 2 clear circles. Foot is stepped and clear on top and is rounded from rim to step. Underside of foot has a fairly deeply articulated conical, ribbed starburst. 1/2" clear band around rim of foot.
