Description

Box of correspondence note cards and envelopes consisting of original box (a-c), 16 note cards (d-s), and 17 envelopes (t-jj). Two different styles of note cards featuring the obverse and reverse of the Pittsburgh Bicentennial Medallion. (a) Box lid. Rectangular light tan paperboard lid with the exterior covered in gold semi-glossy paper. Front of lid has rectangular light tan label with printed image of two card types and black and blue text describing contents. (b) Box bottom. Rectangular white paper envelopes. Adhesive along the inside of the flap.
