### Description

Atomizer (a) with detached black rubber bulb (b), rubber washer (c), and box (d-e). (a) Glass jar with metal top with metal nozzle and broken rubber tubing. Small metal rod inside jar. Engraved on jar is product and maker information. Meant to be attached to black rubber bulb (b) and washer (c). (b) Black rubber bulb with metal collar and brown rubber tubing. Tubing is broken. Meant to be attached to atomizer (a). (c) Small circular rubber washer. Meant to be attached to atomizer (a). (d) Top of box small rectangular box. Exterior is pink and blue plaid on a white background. (e) Bottom of small rectangular box. Pink and blue plaid on white background. Front of box has a large blue sticker with black print. Back of the box has a small oval with print.
