Victory medal (a) with information paper (b), and box lid (c) and bottom (d). (a) Medal attached to a rainbowcolored ribbon. Ribbon has a battle clasp across center, and a metal pin attached to top of ribbon. Raised text on metal battle clasp. Front of medal features an image of a woman wearing a long dress and armor, with a crown on her head, a pair of wings, a sword in her right hand, and a shield in her right hand. Back of medal features an image

of fasces in the center, set against a shield. Text above this image, and text on left and right sides of fasces. Six stars along bottom of medal. (b) Rectangular piece of paper with black and blue typed text throughout. (c) Lid of box is rectangular and made from cardboard, with a sticker attached to center of box, featuring black text. Black or blue stamped text on top edge of lid. (d) Bottom of box is also cardboard and is covered in white paper, except for inside and underside of box.
