Copper teakettle (a) with lid (b). (a) Copper teakettle. Circular base sloping upward to wide shoulder which then narrows to circular opening with rolled rim. Curved spout with V-shaped opening. Curved mushroomshaped folding handle on two mounts; mounts are affixed with two rivets each to kettle body. Imprinted maker text on handle at center. (b) Copper lid. Circular domed lid. Brass(?) handle at center. Base of lid is recessed. Interior of lid is silver-gray metal.
