Description

Half size sculpture model in gray steel of a steelworker. Male steelworker represented in outline in frontal view with head turned to the proper left and holding a long pronged tool in his hands; the tool runs diagonally across his body with his proper right hand uplifted holding the end of the handle and his proper left hand at his side holding the handle near the pronged end. The pronged tool clasps a bar of steel. Cloud-like shapes surround the figure's thighs, and steel mill buildings are represented behind the figure's proper right calf. Model is mounted on

a rectangular piece of plywood with eight bolts and floats approximately 0.5-inch off the surface. The plywood is painted blue-green on the front. Each top corner has a drilled hole with hanging wire strung through. Front bottom proper left corner of the plywood has rectangular paper label with typed black artwork description. Reverse of plywood is unpainted and has a white paper exhibition label adhered to the top proper left area.
