

## Description

Ballpoint pen (a) with certificate of use (b). (a) Black

plastic ballpoint pen. Silver chrome metal band around center and nib end; gray metal endcap on butt end. Brass(?) pen nib with black ink. Tapers toward each end. Between nib and chrome band is decoration printed in silver consisting of the Pennsylvania Coat of Arms and Governor Robert P. Casey's facsimile signature. Two sections of foam remnants on pen from previous mounting methods. (b) Rectangular off-white paper certificate. Certificate has gold embossed Pennsylvania Coat of Arms at top center with blue and black printed, typed, and handwritten text below certifying the pen's (a) use. Above signature and date lines are two yellowed strips of foam where the pen (a) was formerly mounted. Bottom right corner has blue printed union logo.
