Description

Yellowware teapot. Rockingham ware consisting of brown glaze with mottled yellow glaze. Interior and underside are primarily yellow glaze. Sunken rim for lid, but teapot has no lid. Rim has two lobes for locking lid in place. Ten-

sided body. Body is narrower at top and widens toward bottom of body where it then recedes to base. S-curve spout with curvilinear carvings near top and bottom. Applied handle with thumb rest on top. Footed base. Body has shallow relief of bucolic life depicting a woman next to a well with a jug in her arms, the woman is surrounded by trees; this is possibly the biblical scene of Rebecca at the well. Underside has circular orange sticker at center with handwritten number and price.
